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The next time you visit your optical, chiropractic or physiotherapy provider, show your Alberta Blue Cross ID card and enjoy the convenience of direct billing of your claims through online claims submission.

If your Alberta Blue Cross benefit plan includes vision care, chiropractic or physiotherapy benefits, you can enjoy the convenience of direct billing up to your contractual benefit maximum. However, you **must** show your Alberta Blue Cross ID card to ensure your provider has the correct coverage information and knows

to use the online claim submission service for your claims.

Direct billing reduces the need for you to pay the full cost for eligible claims and then wait to be reimbursed. Your out-of-pocket amount may be significantly reduced or completely eliminated.

With online claims submission providers can submit claims online at the time of service through an easy-to-use secure web site created and maintained by Alberta Blue Cross. The site allows providers to check patient coverage and determine the amount Alberta Blue Cross

will pay to their office on your behalf, as well as the amount—if any—their office needs to collect from you. Processing is completed and results are displayed immediately. You are still responsible for payment of any co-pay or deductible amounts.

Travelling to **Cuba?**

If you're planning vacation travels to Cuba this winter, ensure you take appropriate travel insurance documentation with you when you go. As of May 1, 2010, Cuba made it mandatory for all visitors to hold either travel health insurance from providers approved by the Cuban government, or health insurance purchased from Cuban vendors at its port of entry. Alberta Blue Cross travel coverage is deemed by Cuba as acceptable insurance. Remember to pack your passport, provincial health care card, Alberta Blue Cross ID card, and benefit booklet in your carry-on luggage.

Understanding your dental benefits

In Alberta, individual dental providers are able to set their own prices. This differs from many other provinces where dentists follow a fee guide established by provincial dental associations. As a result, dental offices across Alberta charge widely varying prices for dental services.

Despite the fact that each year Alberta Blue Cross adjusts the rates paid to dental providers through your plan to ensure fair and reasonable rates, your dentist may still charge more than your plan covers. This means you could face out-of-pocket costs regardless of the basis of payment or the level of coverage provided through your plan.

All Alberta dental offices have quick and easy access to information about your dental coverage through our convenient telephone information system or online. Most dental offices submit claims online to Alberta Blue Cross right at the time of your appointment, which means you can know instantly if you have any outstanding balance such as a co-pay or a deductible (where applicable). In fact, your dentist can quickly check how much your plan

pays for dental procedures and how much, if anything, you will have to pay by submitting a predetermination to Alberta Blue Cross prior to your appointment. Be sure to ask your dentist about this convenient service.

In today's market of rising dental fees, we encourage you to take an active role in ensuring you are getting the best value for your dental services and making the most of your dental benefits.

You can even print a claims summary if required for income tax purposes.
