

Overview of List Views in Pharmacy Console

The **Pharmacy Console** app within AVBS provides you with access to different list views, including the following:

Profiles

All Pharmacy Profiles

Appointments

- All Appointments
- Appointments in next 5 days
- Last Minute Appointments
- Last Minute Cancellations
- Patients with Appointments Today
- Patients with Appointments Tomorrow
- Recently Viewed
- Today's Appointments
- Tomorrow's Appointments

These lists of records are **in-built Salesforce views** and are different from **custom-built reports**. All of these lists can be filtered by different parameters and viewed in a printable format for printing or saving as a PDF in your local machine.




Navigating to List Views in Pharmacy console

To navigate to Appointment list views, follow the steps below:

1 Click on the **Appointments** Tab on the Homepage

You will be defaulted to the **Recently Viewed** List.








Recently Viewed:

List of recently viewed profiles in AVBS and their information, such as **Profile Name**, **Health Card Number**, **Registration Confirmation Number**, **Birthdate**, **Potential Duplicate**, **Email**, **Mobile Number**, and **Preferred Communication Channel**. This list includes all records that have a Profile (e.g. Vaccination Sites and Albertans).











Profiles Available in List View

Once you have selected the list you would like to view, the respective list view will open in a new page.










Saving and Printing a List


To save and print a list, follow the steps below:

1 After opening the list, click on the **Print** button.

A new window will open with a printable view of the list.

2 Click on **Print This Page** link.


A new window will pop up that will allow you to select the options for either saving the list as PDF or printing.





Saving and Printing a List (Continued)

- 3 Select the **Destination**, either Save as PDF or Print.
- Click **Save** to save the list as a PDF or **Print** to print the list view(s).






List View vs. Reports


There are some differences between a List in AVBS and custom-built AVBS Reports:

LIST VIEW



- 1. Allows users to view and edit data
- Does not allow grouping, summarizing and calculating data
- Does not allow exporting data to Excel
- 4. Allows users to print the table
- 5. Can only display data stored on the tab in which the list view is created (E.g., Appointments)

REPORTS



- 1. Does not allow users to edit data
- 2. Allow for **grouping**, **summarizing** and **calculating data** (sums, averages, etc.)
- 3. Allow for easy exporting data to Excel
- Can display data stored on other (related) objects, depending on the Record Type selected (E.g., Registrations with Appointments)
