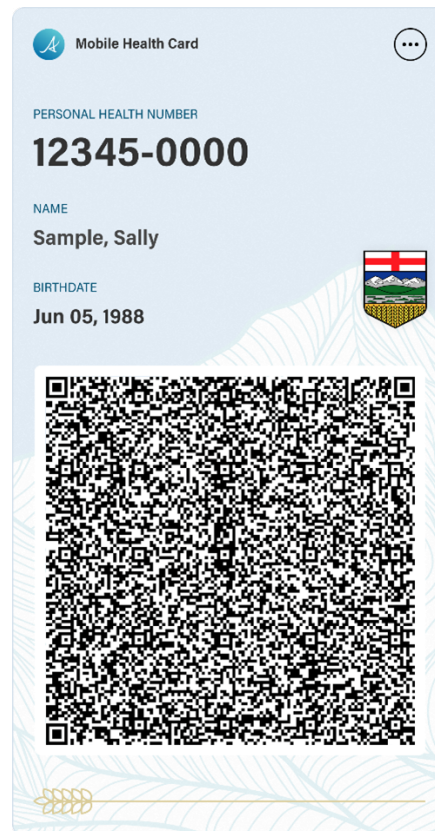
Change to Alberta Personal Health Card

As part of its commitment to provide Albertans with added convenience, Primary and Preventative Health Services will offer a new mobile health card option, effective August 29, 2025, in addition to the current paper health card.

Albertans can obtain a mobile health card through the Alberta Wallet. To access the Alberta Wallet, Albertans will need to have verified accounts for [Alberta.ca](https://alberta.ca) and [MyHealth Records](https://myhealthrecords.ca).

Validity of the current physical card

The current paper health card will remain in circulation and valid during this transition to the new health cards. Albertans holding a valid paper health card can still use that card until the date it is deemed no longer valid.
