GOVERNMENT OF NORTHWEST TERRITORIES (GNWT) PHARMACY REFERENCE GUIDE FOR MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

The GNWT sponsors the following extended health benefits programs for eligible residents of the Northwest Territories: Métis Health Benefits (Group 19866), Extended Health Benefits for Specified Disease Conditions (Group 21992) and Extended Health Benefits for Seniors (Group 60). Alberta Blue Cross administers benefits for these programs on behalf of the GNWT.

Medical Supplies and Equipment (MSE)

The program will pay reasonable and customary charges for medically necessary supplies and equipment provided in Canada as defined by the <u>Non-Insured Health Benefit (NIHB) Medical Supplies</u> <u>and Equipment Guide and Benefit Lists</u>.

To make a claim for many of these products, clients require a prescription or written order from a recognized health care professional.

Prior approval

MSE listed as requiring prior approval on the NIHB formularies require the client to meet specific criteria for coverage. To receive benefits in this category, prior approval must be obtained from Alberta Blue Cross.

MSE prior approval requests must include the appropriate pseudo-Product Identification Numbers (PINs). The PINs for MSE benefits for GNWT can be **found here**.

Claiming for GNWT programs

Real-time claim submission

Manual claims submission

For MSE, which cannot be submitted in real-time, claims may be submitted by faxing or mailing the original invoice(s) and the following information to Alberta Blue Cross:

- a copy of the approved prior approval form (when a prior approval is required)
- Northwest Territories (NWT) health care plan number
- patient name
- date of service
