Temporary benefit added to the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*

Due to the unavailability of Suprax 400 mg Tablet (DIN 00868981), manufactured by Sanofi-Aventis, Auro-Cefixime 400 mg Tablet (DIN 02432773), manufactured by Auro Pharma Inc., will be considered a temporary benefit on the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*.

As of January 12, 2015, all claims for Auro-Cefixime 400 mg Tablet (DIN 02432773) will be adjudicated to the price published in the most recent *Alberta Blue Cross Drug Price List (ABCDPL)* until further notice. The *ABCDPL* is available online at www.ab.bluecross.ca/providers/pharmacy-home.html.

If this situation continues to be a long-term matter, this product will be subject to the usual review process by the Expert Committee on Drug Evaluation and Therapeutics and must be approved by the Minister of Health for addition to the *ADBL* in order to remain as a benefit.
