## Removal of temporary benefits from the Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)

Due to the shortages of Apo-Propafenone 300 mg Tablet (DIN 02243325), manufactured by Apotex Inc., and Rythmol 300 mg Tablet (DIN 00603716), manufactured by Abbott Laboratories Limited, the below products were added as temporary benefits for the Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL).

Abbott Laboratories Limited has advised Alberta Blue Cross that the shortage of Rythmol 300 mg Tablet (DIN 00603716) has now been resolved.

As a result, the below products will no longer be considered as temporary benefits for the ADBL **after April 23, 2015**.
