Alberta Blue Cross® Pharmaceutical Services Provider Agreement Compliance Verification Review Update

At Alberta Blue Cross, we are committed to safeguarding the value and sustainability of the benefit plans and programs we are entrusted to administer. To ensure plan sponsor payment of eligible claims is done appropriately, we employ strategies to protect the integrity of our customers' benefit plans.

Claims submission for compound prescriptions

The completion of recent Compliance Verification Reviews determined some pharmacy providers were claiming for compound prescriptions that were ineligible due to

- · duplication of a manufactured drug, drug product or product, for example, glycopyrrolate and levetiracetam; and
- inclusion of at least one or more ineligible ingredient(s), specific to a member's plan, for example, hydroquinone and kojic acid.

The reviews resulted in recovery. As part of our process, we have returned the monies directly back to the plan sponsor in fulfillment of our obligation to ensure the sustainability of their benefit plans.

We would like to remind pharmacy providers that all claims for compound prescriptions must be eligible based on member's coverage, must not duplicate a commercially available product at the time of claim and must not include an ineligible ingredient.

Subsection 3.4 (e) of the agreement states:

Alberta Blue Cross will only pay Claims which comply strictly with the applicable Coverage.

Paragraph 2.4 (c)(i) of appendix A of the agreement states:

A Compound and a Purchased Compound must not duplicate a drug, a drug product or a product which is manufactured unless Alberta Blue Cross has provided its prior authorization by either telephone or electronic transmission.
