

## ***Update on shortage of specialized infant formula***

### **Importation of United States-labelled Similac Alimentum Infant Formula (6 x 946 mL bottles) due to shortage of specialized infant formula**

Due to the shortage of extensively hydrolyzed infant formulas in Canada, Health Canada has allowed the importation from the United States of Abbott Nutrition's **Similac Alimentum Infant Formula**. **This product is to be kept behind the counter of the pharmacy.**

**Note:** Supply of this imported **Similac Alimentum Infant Formula** is expected to arrive in Alberta the week of June 20, 2022, and will be distributed through wholesalers such as McKesson.

#### **Temporary benefit added to the *Alberta Human Services Drug Benefit Supplement (HSDBS)***

To ensure coverage is provided for this product, for members of eligible government-sponsored drug programs, **a temporary Product Identification Number has been assigned to this (US) Similac Alimentum Infant Formula (PIN: 00999299).**

As of **June 20, 2022**, all claims for the above product will be adjudicated to the price of **\$0.0059 per mL**.
