# Real-Time Integration (RTI) needed for Alberta pharmacies by July 1, 2026

Beginning July 1, 2026, Alberta Blue Cross® will no longer upload immunization claims to the provincial immunization repository (lmm/ARI) on behalf of pharmacies. This change means all community pharmacies participating in the provincial immunization program must adopt a Real-Time Integration (RTI) system by July 1, 2026. One benefit of this change is it will help reduce duplication of immunization records. During the transition to RTI-Imm/ARI, and until July 1, 2026, Alberta Blue Cross will continue to upload immunization claims to Imm/ARI. Therefore, pharmacies that have not transitioned to RTI-Imm/ARI will continue to use the traditional PINs. **Please note:** Pharmacies enabled with RTI for Imm/ARI submissions will have their data automatically uploaded to Imm/ARI, provided they have completed a Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) that includes this transmission of data to ImmARI. #### Update to claim processes for Real-Time Integration (RTI)

For pharmacies that have completed the installation of real-time integration (RTI) with Netcare, claims for Assessment for the Administration of a Provincially Funded Vaccine must be submitted using the appropriate Product Identification Numbers (PINs) below.

### Assessment for the Administration of a Provincially Funded Vaccine administered by a community pharmacy

Influenza vaccine	00999666	\$13
Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine	00999659	\$13

Pneumococcal vaccine	00999664	\$13

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#### Reminder: Submission of privately purchased vaccines

- Do not use Alberta Blue Cross claims submission to report privately purchased vaccines to the Ministry or Netcare
