URGENT! Clarification on immunization submissions to Netcare and PINs

This notice provides clarification on the proper use of PINs for submitting immunization records to Alberta's Provincial Immunization Repository (ImmARI). The information submitted to the Alberta Immunization Repository (ImmARI) is subsequently shared with Alberta Netcare and displayed in a client's immunization history.

For clarification, the existing PINs for provincially funded vaccinations are listed below:

Currently, only a **very limited number** of pharmacies are configured for direct RTI submissions for immunization. More information on the transition away from Alberta Blue Cross® feed will follow in coming months.

Having an existing RTI setup for Netcare and medication dispenses **does not** automatically enable your site to submit immunizations through RTI.

Alberta Blue Cross, in collaboration with Primary and Preventative Health Services (PPHS), will ensure that immunization records submitted between October 20 and October 26 (inclusive) are processed and submitted to Netcare. Pharmacies are advised to review their submissions and verify that all records appear in Netcare by the end of October. If any records are missing, pharmacies should submit them using the correct PINs to ensure completeness.

Reminder: Immunization submissions and billing practices

Primary and Preventive Health Services (PPHS), Alberta Blue Cross along with Alberta College of Pharmacies reminds pharmacies that immunization submissions to Netcare should only occur at the same time as vaccine is being administered.

Submitting billing claims days before vaccine administration can lead to data quality and audit issues, such as unreversed claims if an individual does not attend and discrepancies between billing and clinical records in Imm/ARI.

To maintain accurate and reliable immunization data across Alberta's provincial systems, billing and administration submissions must be completed only during or after the vaccination.

As per the Immunization Regulation all pharmacies must report the administration of **privately purchased** vaccines to Alberta's provincial immunization repository (ImmARI) through IDSM or another approved direct submission mechanism.

PPHS appreciates your continued cooperation in ensuring the integrity of Alberta's immunization data.
