## Removal of temporary benefits from the Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)

Due to the shortage of Pdp-Erythromycin 5 mg/g Ophthalmic Ointment (DIN 01912755) manufactured by Pendopharm Inc., Odan-Erythromycin 5 mg/g Ophthalmic Ointment (DIN 00641324) manufactured by Odan Laboratories Limited was added as a temporary benefit for the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*.

Pendopharm Inc. has advised Alberta Blue Cross that the shortage of Pdp-Erythromycin 5 mg/g Ophthalmic Ointment (DIN 01912755) has been resolved. As a result, Odan-Erythromycin 5 mg/g Ophthalmic Ointment (DIN 00641324) will no longer be considered a temporary benefit for the *ADBL* **after June 23, 2017**.

Due to the shortage of Teva-Gemfibrozil 300 mg Capsule (DIN 02241704) manufactured by Teva Canada Limited and Apo-Gemfibrozil 300 mg Capsule (DIN 01979574) manufactured by Apotex Inc., pms-Gemfibrozil 300 mg Capsule (DIN 02239951) manufactured by Pharmascience Inc. was added as a temporary benefit for the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*.

Teva Canada Limited has advised Alberta Blue Cross that the shortage of Teva-Gemfibrozil 300 mg Capsule (DIN 02241704) has been resolved. As a result, pms-Gemfibrozil 300 mg Capsule (DIN 02239951) will no longer be considered a temporary benefit for the *ADBL* **after June 26, 2017**.
